

Facilities Hygiene Guidelines

The health and safety of our students, staff, families and community are our utmost concern; therefore, JRS CDCA is implementing health and safety measures for our employees and students. We have a collective commitment to support a healthy community by promoting well-being and following current orders issued by the Alabama Department of Public Health (ADPH) and guidelines outlined by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

Before Entering the Campus:

If you are ill or if you answer “yes” to any of the following questions, we ask that you not enter our facility.

- Have you been in close contact with a confirmed case of COVID- 19?
- Are you experiencing a cough, shortness of breath or sore throat?
- Have you had a fever in the last 48 hours?
- Have you experienced new loss of taste or smell?
- Have you experienced vomiting or diarrhea in the last 24 hours?

While on Campus:

- Practice social distancing of at least 6 feet, whether inside or outside campus.
- Face masks must be worn by all participants, and social distancing of at least 6 feet must be practiced.
- Practice frequent, appropriate handwashing of at least 20 seconds (per CDC guidelines) or use alcohol -based (at least 60% alcohol) hand sanitizer if soap and water are not available.
- Wear a cloth face masks while on campus unless alone in a space other than a common area (such as a classroom or office).
- Wear gloves when handling mail, paper copies, items for pickup and delivery, or when there is a potential exposure to blood or bodily fluids. Follow the “WHO Glove Use Information Leaflet” when applying (donning) and removing (donning) gloves, available in common areas on campus.
- Cover your cough or sneeze by coughing or sneezing into your elbow or into a tissue.
- Avoid touching your face, eyes, nose and mouth.
- Avoid handshaking.
- Avoid using other’s phones, desks, offices or other work tools and equipment, when possible. If necessary, clean and disinfect these items before and after use.
- **Do not share headsets and store individually.**

Common Areas on Campus:

- Avoid common areas, if it feasible. Do not conjugate in common areas.
- Wear mask always while in common areas.
- Self-serve items and the common areas such as self-serve drink machines, break rooms refrigerators and microwaves will be closed for use. Coffee pots/machines, coffee supplies self-serve food items, buffet lines, etc. are not permitted.

Cleaning:

- Buildings will be clean and disinfected daily, according to the CDC guidelines.
- Frequently touched surfaces and items should be cleaned and disinfected often.
